- Full f* O give thanks unto the Lord for ' he is ' gracious :  
and his ' mercy en'dureth for ' ever.
- Full* 2 Who can express the noble ' acts of the ' Lord :  
or ' shew forth ' all his ' praise?
- D mf* 3 Blessed are ' they that ' always <sup>||</sup> keep ' judgement ' and do ' righteousness.
- C* 4 Remember me O Lord, according to the favour that thou bearest ' unto thy ' people :  
O ' visit · me with ' thy sal'vation,
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Part*
- C* 5 That I may see the felicity ' of thy ' chosen :  
and rejoice in the gladness of thy people,  
and give ' thanks with ' thine in'heritance.
- D mp* 6 We have ' sinned · with our ' fathers :  
we have ' done a'miss and dealt ' wickedly.
- C* 7 Our fathers regarded not thy wonders in Egypt,  
neither kept they thy great ' goodness · in re'membrance :  
but were disobedient at the sea ' even · at the ' Red - ' sea.
- D mf* 8 Nevertheless, he ' helped them · for his ' Name's sake :  
that he might ' make his ' power · to be ' known.
- C* 9 He rebuked the Red sea also, and it was ' dri-ed ' up :  
so he led them through the ' deep as ' through a ' wilderness.
- D* 10 And he saved them from the ' adver·sary's ' hand :  
and delivered them ' from the ' hand of the ' enemy.
- C* 11 As for those that troubled them, the ' waters · over'whelmed them :  
there ' was not ' one of them ' left.
