even the ' work of ' men's - ' hands.

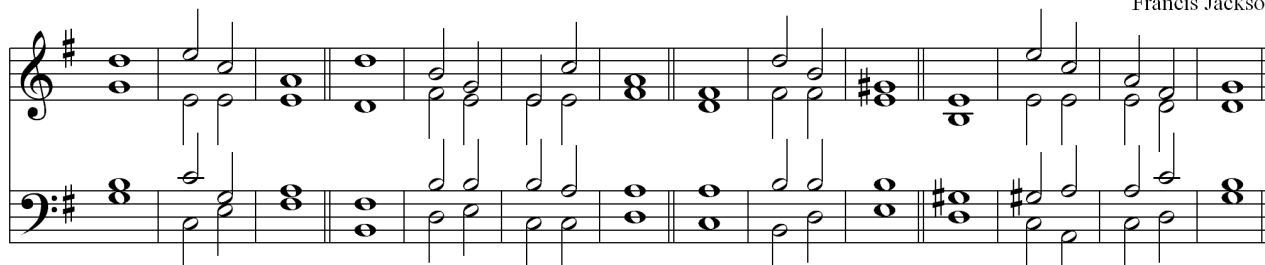
D 5. They have ' mouths and ' speak not :

he is their ' succour ' and de'fence.

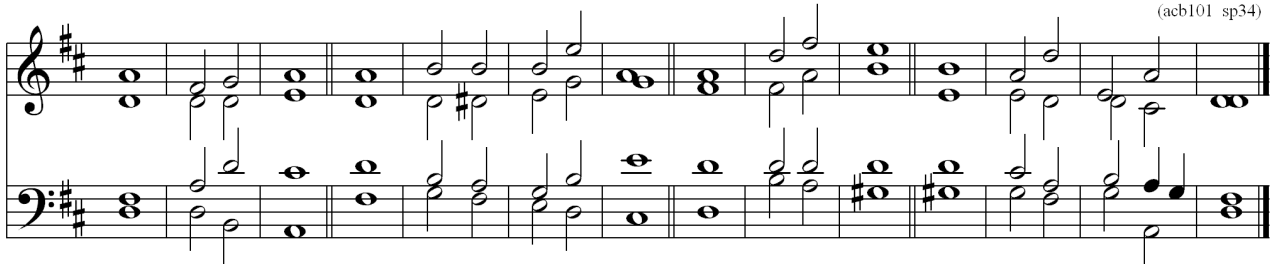
Full 10. Ye house of Aaron, put your ' trust · in the ' Lord :
