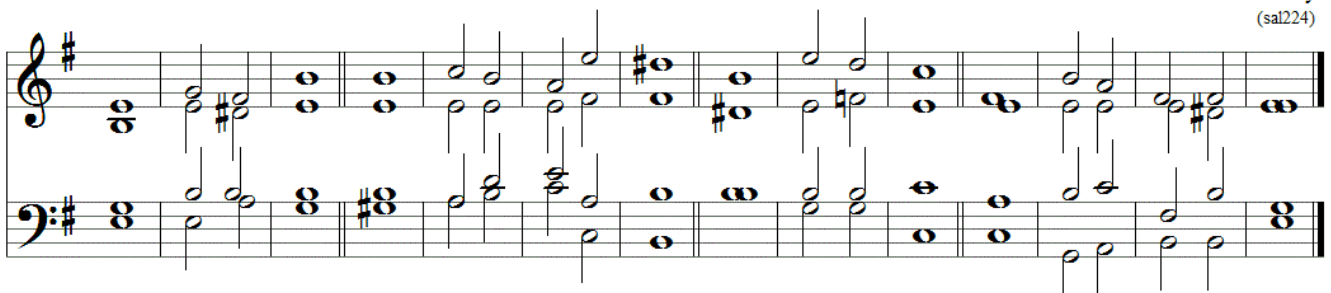


Psalm 119 vv 17-24 *Retribue servo tuo* (OP)

- D mf* 17 O do ' well un·to thy ' servant :
that I may ' live and ' keep thy ' word.
- C* 18 Open ' thou mine ' eyes :
that I may see the ' won·drous ' things of thy ' law.
- D mp* 19 I am a ' stranger up·on ' earth :
O hide not ' thy com'mand·ments ' from me.
- C* 20 My soul breaketh out for the very ' fervent de'sire :
that it hath ' al·way ' unto thy ' judgements.
- D mf* 21 Thou hast re'buked the ' proud :
and cursed are they that do ' err from ' thy com'mandments.
- C* 22 O turn from me ' shame · and re'buke :
for ' I have ' kept thy ' testimonies.
- D* 23 Princes also did sit and ' speak a'gainst me :
but thy servant is ' occupied ' in thy ' statutes.

- D p* 25 My soul ' cleaveth · to the ' dust :
O quicken thou me ac'cording ' to thy ' word.
- C* 26 I have acknowledged my ' ways and thou ' heardest me :
O ' teach - ' me thy ' statutes.
- D* 27 Make me to understand the way of ' thy com'mandments :
and so shall I ' talk of thy ' wondrous ' works.
- C* 28 My soul melteth away for ' very ' heaviness :
comfort thou me ac'cording ' unto thy ' word.
- D mp* 29 Take from me the ' way of ' lying :
and cause thou ' me to make ' much of thy ' law.
- C mf* 30 I have chosen the ' way of ' truth :
and thy ' judgements · have I ' laid be'fore me.
- D* 31 I have ' stuck un·to thy ' testimonies :
O ' Lord con'found me ' not.
- C dim* 32 I will run the way of ' thy com'mandments :
when thou hast ' set my ' heart at ' liberty.
